



**T**hough the smallest of Neel's trimarans, the Neel 43 is no less impressive. As with the rest of the Neel line, the boat doesn't lack for either accommodation or storage space, with eight berths (three doubles and two singles forward in each ama) and a large "garage" set low in the central hull for containing things like the engine, tanks and tools. Also like its predecessor, the 43 features what Neel calls its "cockloot," a versatile living space that allows for free movement between the indoor and outdoor spaces, all well pro-

tected by a hardtop. The hulls and deck are constructed in a vacuum-infused composite sandwich with carbon-fiber reinforcements in high-load areas. A narrow central hull, svelte amas and a powerful rig all promise the same kind of sparkling performance Neel has long been known for.
